WORLD-CITIZEN BEN FULLER RELEASES DEBUT ALBUM AQUARIAN SON

SONGWRITER FINDS INSPIRATION FROM TRAVELS ACROSS THE GLOBE

(LOS ANGELES, CA) – **Ben Fuller's** debut solo EP, *Aquarian Son*, due for release March 16, 2010 through 4th Born Productions, highlights this talented traveler's gift for songwriting and crafting meaningful music. Ben's Americana-style music takes shape naturally as he moves through life, "Music is a great common denominator," he says, "that's why I value exploring new places and meeting new people. These encounters constantly influence my music." *Aquarian Son* will be available through Internet and local retail outlets nationwide.

Having moved from Southern California, to the Northeast, and back to the West Coast again, **Fuller** has had his share of the American experience. From living in Alaskan tree-houses to driving in a vintage school bus across the country with his wife, Tanya and their wolf-dog Tipu, **Fuller** has lived in ways many would never dream of doing. The opening track, "Ashes", is a song he wrote with his songwriter-wife Tanya during one fall in Missoula, Montana; capturing a time of year when life transitions into a slower, more reflective pace. The track "California" is an ode to his childhood roots and the influences he found there. As part of The Deep Roots Project (local artists encouraging high school-age songwriters) while residing in Portland, OR, **Fuller** was inspired to write the song "Inside Out", an engaging song about approaching adulthood while holding onto one's youth.

"I've traveled in Europe and the African continent," remarked Fuller. "All of the places and people I've encountered along the way shape my music. I always have a guitar in hand." Watching the sunrise from the summit of Mt. Kilimanjaro gained the singer/songwriter an even deeper perspective; **Fuller** relates that "the profound impact of that moment, lead me to the realization that every place and person I meet has a story".

Aquarian Son was produced by Scott Fisher, mixed by Krish Sharma (Rolling Stones, Counting Crows) and multiple Grammy nominee Jesus "Chuy" Flores (Ricky Martin, Badly Drawn Boy), and mastered by Eddy Schreyer (Bob Dylan, Tracy Chapman). Backed by an accomplished group of musicians; Zane Carney (Carney), Jeff Anthony (Sheryl Crow), Robin Everhart (Rival Sons) and Justin Hopkins (Justin Hopkins and The Guilt), combined with Fuller's inspirations made for a true storybook of true travels and life experiences exhibited on *Aquarian Son*.

Delivering a crisp and artistic EP, **Fuller** believes every song is unique and introspective, declaring the project "exactly how life experiences should be. I take something with me from everything that I do, let it simmer and then make it my own."
